## OUTSIDE WORLD OUTFITTERS LEADS SEARCH FOR BIGFOOT

Local Outdoor Retailer Raises Awareness for Hemlock Trees Through Halloween Event.

**Dawsonville, GA. Oct. 13** – Outside World Outfitters, North Georgia's leading outdoor retailer of kayaks and outdoor gear, has teamed up with Gold Rush Jeeps of Dahlonega, GA to search for Bigfoot. As Bigfoot moves north, Outside World Outfitters will partner with Gold Rush Jeeps on Saturday, October 28<sup>th</sup> to sponsor the event, "Hike For Bigfoot and Jeep Trunk or Treat." At the event, the leaders of the Bigfoot Search Committee hope to find Bigfoot with the help of participants, and then return to Gold Rush Jeeps to celebrate Halloween with dinner and a trunk or treat. A raffle will be held to raise money for Save Georgia's Hemlocks, so Bigfoot can return to his home in the North Georgia mountains.
