9:45	Sign in and distribution of training materials
10:00	Overview of hemlock treatment project and schedule for the day
10:15	Instruction for treatment tasks: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • soil injector, its use and care; • quick reference card, how to read and use; • treatment material, how to mix, how to load into injector; • data sheet and how to read; • treatment process; • application of tags and update of data sheet; • calling for more chemical if needed; • cleaning the application devices and other equipment upon completion of work; and • safety – personal and environmental.
11:00	Distribution of maps, equipment, and work supplies Mixing of chemicals

Field Work

11:15	Travel to work sites – take sack lunch, drink, cell phone, extra water for mixing more chemical
11:30	Begin treatment tasks, taking an on-site lunch break as scheduled by each team <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • loading treatment mixture into soil injector; • locating each chosen tree listed on data sheet; • raking back leaves / debris within a foot of base of tree to expose bare dirt; • treating each tree with correct dosage and marking it as treated on data sheet; • replacing flagging tape with pre-numbered metal tag listed on data sheet; and • replacing previously removed ground cover.
