Review -- Accomplishments and financial condition at end of 2009 (11/30/09)

Program expansion – Roll-out of Hemlock Help program in 3 more counties in early spring 2010; Hemlock Help Clinics for new and currently implemented counties; placement of additional soil injectors and identification of additional local sellers of treatment products.

Internal education – Additional research, participation in citizen science initiatives, publishing, and training of additional Facilitators.

External outreach – Targeted communications and service engagements for resident and non-resident stakeholders.

Financial resources -- Funding plan for drawing increased financial and functional support from a broad community base of individuals and organizations and strategy for sharing resources charitably in support of common goals. Update on 501(c)3 status.

Service capability – Plan for increasing organizational partnerships, volunteer core, and community action to include special Hemlock Help projects on private and public lands.
