

Chemicals, Contacts and Sources

Below is a partial list of products for treating hemlocks and a partial list of sources where they can be purchased. Both lists are meant for informational purposes only, not as product or source endorsements. The availability of specific products and the prices vary widely among retail sources. Consumers are advised to check several sources to compare pricing.

Primary Chemicals

For **lightly to moderately infested hemlocks**, the primary treatment chemical is Imidacloprid. The original flagship brand is Bayer's Merit 75 WSP, costs about \$92 per four-pack, treats an average of 180 diameter inches, and provides 5-6 years of protection.

Here are the names of the most common **generic 75% water-soluble powder products**. Each four-pack costs about \$33, treats an average of 180 diameter inches, and provides 5-6 years of protection.

There are also **economical generic liquid products** that are sold by the gallon for about \$75, treat an average of 1,208 diameter inches, and provide 5-6 years of protection:

For **heavily infested hemlocks**, hemlocks that are in decline, or very large infested hemlocks (greater than 20 inches in diameter) that are showing zero or minimal new growth, the primary treatment chemical is Dinotefuran, sold as Safari 20 SG and TransTect 70 WSP. Safari 20 SG is a soluble granular product sold in a 12-oz bottle for about \$115, treating an average of 70 diameter inches, or a 3-lb jug for about \$400, treating an average of 283 diameter inches. TransTect 70 WSP is a powdered product sold in a canister of twenty 0.6-oz packets for about \$370, treating an average of 248 diameter inches. Both products provide 1-2 years of protection.
